

Income guidelines

Find your family size on the *May Qualify For Children’s Medicaid* chart. Is the money your family makes the same or less than the monthly or yearly income? (Income is money you get paid before taxes are taken out.) If so, your children might get Medicaid.

*A family of one might be a child who does not live with a parent or other relative.

If your income is higher, your children might get CHIP if the money your family makes is the same or less than the monthly or yearly income shown in the *May Qualify For CHIP* chart.
