Summary of Position

The Warehouse Manager is responsible for the overall coordination, management and supervisor of the High Plains Food Bank's total warehouse operations and physical plant. Which includes: warehouse staff, vehicles, equipment, and warehouse/building facilities.

Summary of Duties/Responsibilities

- 1. Responsible for cleaning, safety, self-inspections, employee training, temperature logs, pest logs, and others that may be necessary to maintain highest quality of facilities
- 2. Plans and coordinates City / Rural Route Delivery service and pickups
- 3. Maintains all necessary records in regards to Vehicle and Service Requests
- 4. Responsible for responding to security issues after hours
- 5. Builds necessary spreadsheets in accordance for record keeping
- 6. Provides accurate and timely reports and documentation as required by federal and state representatives, contractors, Feeding America, and Inventory Control Manager
- 7. Determines and coordinates with the Assistant Director / Inventory Manager about the cycle count process, staff participation, record keeping, data collection, and information management
- 8. Responsible for the coordination of dumping spoiled, outdated or undeliverable food product with the approval of the Assistant Director
- 9. All other duties as assigned by supervisor
